Andrew is the Managing Director of the Global Listed Infrastructure strategy at Maple-Brown Abbott, which he started with his partners in 2012. Andrew is an infrastructure expert having over 20 years' experience in financing and investing in infrastructure assets and securities. In addition to being a portfolio manager for the strategy, he is also responsible for coverage of regulated utilities across North America.

Prior to joining Maple-Brown Abbott, Andrew spent over 11 years working for Macquarie Group and 5 years at Lend Lease before that. Initially Andrew's focus was on the debt structuring and financing of direct infrastructure assets, both in Australia and offshore.

In 2007, Andrew joined Macquarie's Global Listed Infrastructure team as a Portfolio Manager. He spent two years in this role in Sydney, before relocating to the New York office for 3 years, and then returning to Sydney in early 2012.
